

# TERMS & CONDITIONS GROWEDU TRAINERS 2020

## Section 1. The Organiser

The organiser of the GrowEdu project (also named generically as 'The Project') is the School of Values Association (also named generically as 'The Organiser'), located at Str. Soldat Neagu Florea nr.7, etaj 1, Bucureşti, România, registered in the Register of Associations and Foundations with no. 27/04.03.2010, fiscal code no. 26781002 and IBAN number RO03BACX0000000940524000.

The organiser will take up the administration of the project, the communications of the project, the applications and the validation of applications. Data processing happens in conformity with Law 190/2018 regarding measures of facilitation of the EU Regulation 2016/678 of the European Parliament and of the Council of the 27th of April 2016 regarding the protection of physical persons in relation to data processing and the free flow of this type of data and of enforcement of Directive 95/46/CE (General Regulation of Data Protection). The project will run in relation to the sections of this Regulation, which is mandatory for all participants. The organiser reserves the right to modify this Regulation throughout the duration of the project and will bring these changes to the public by publishing these Regulation changes on the website [www.growedu.ro](http://www.growedu.ro).

## Section 2. Project area

The project is organized and takes place online.

## Section 3. Right of Participation

The project is addressed to all trainers regardless of their nationality or current residential status, with a maximum age of 35. They need to know English at an advanced level / minimum C1.

Trainers who have participated in one of the previous editions of the GrowEdu project can re-enroll, provided that they find themselves in the above stated conditions.

#### **Section 4. Participation fee**

There is no participation/enrollment fee for those who want to join the camp as trainers. A volunteer agreement will be signed.

Also, it is important to note that the volunteers will not receive any financial compensation, salary, monetized reward, etc. in exchange for their participation in the programme.

It is the responsibility of the trainers to ensure they have access to a computer and the Internet to participate in the online workshops.

#### **Section 5. Project Stages**

The registration period is from 1 July to 10 August, 2020. The deadline for application to join the Project as a trainer by filling in the registration form on [www.growedu.ro](http://www.growedu.ro) is 10 August, 2020, 23:59 EEST.

The announcement of the selected trainers will take place from 10-20 August 2020. The trainers will receive the detailed agenda of the project in the period 20-24 August 2020.

The online Train the Trainers preparatory seminar will take place between 20-24 August 2020.

The online workshops will be conducted between 31 August to 4 September, 2020.

The Step Up projects (will also be organized online) from September 2020.

#### **Section 6. Project Application Mechanism**

Those interested in the Project can register by filling in the registration form on the website [www.growedu.ro](http://www.growedu.ro) until August 10, 2020, at 23:59 EEST.

The organizer does not assume responsibility for failure to complete the registration form within the specified time.

There will be 20 trainers selected who will be able to participate and deliver in the 10 modules of the project, structured in the form of online workshops, on topics such as: life skills, values, multiculturalism, entrepreneurship, leadership, EU matters, exchange of experience between generations etc.

By enrolling, trainers commit to volunteering which consists of being present at the sessions on the agenda they are assigned to deliver.

The list of trainers will be published on the website [www.growedu.ro](http://www.growedu.ro) no later than 20 August 2020. The trainers to be selected will be notified in writing by email about the result obtained, no later than 20 August 2020. In case it is difficult to choose because of certain “equal” applications, the organizers will move forward with the candidates who expressed their full availability.

## Section 7. Selection Criteria

The selection of applicant trainers for all project categories will be made based on the following scoring system:

1	The recruitment assessment should be fully completed and sent in the deadline.	20%
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2	Commitment of the trainer to deliver as a full trainer at least 50% of the available workshops in the camp.	30%
3	Previous training experience Outstanding English skills, both oral and written Communication skills, both oral and written	50%

**Section 8. Jurisdiction**

The selection of candidates will be made based on the evaluation of all validity criteria mentioned in Section no. 7 of this Regulation. Applications will be evaluated by the Training Coordinators.

**Section 9. Commitments, Data Confidentiality**

By registering for the GrowEdu Project, participants confirm their acknowledgement of this registration guide clauses and express their agreement to them. Enrollment in the project implies the obligation to comply with the clauses of this enrollment guide. The organizer may request the parent or legal representative of the scholarship recipient, the consent for him or the sponsor to use, free of charge, in various printed materials, audio, and video, the name, surname, place of residence, image and voice of the scholarship recipients. In order to express their express agreement to this effect, the parent or legal representative of the beneficiary will sign a statement containing the terms of this agreement. The organizer does not condition participation in the project by signing this declaration.

The organizer guarantees the confidentiality of the personal data of the participants in this project; the collection of personal data mentioned in the registration form: name, surname, place, and date of birth, parents' names, full address, telephone number, e-mail address; and that it is made exclusively for the purpose of accurately identifying participants and contacting them.

The project participant, his parents or legal representatives, as data subjects, have, in accordance with the European Parliament and Council Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of 27 April 2016 on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data, and on the free movement of such data, as well in accordance with Law 190 of 2018 on the application of this Regulation in Romania, the following rights: the right to information, the right to access data, the right to intervene on data, the right to oppose, the right not to be subject to automatic processing decisions, and the right to address the National Authority for the Supervision of Personal Data Processing. Participants have the right to a request, free of charge, the confirmation that the data concerning them is or will not be processed by it and also have the right to object at any time, for well-founded and legitimate reasons related to their particular situation, that their data is subject to processing unless otherwise provided by law.

Participants have the right to request, through a written request, addressed to the organizer, the deletion or update of their personal data in accordance with the clauses of the European Parliament and Council Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of 27 April 2016, on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data and the free movement of such data. In order to exercise these rights, the participant will send a written request, in which the name of the applicant, the project he is part of and the year in which he participated will be clearly highlighted, to the email address [dpo@scoaladevalori.ro](mailto:dpo@scoaladevalori.ro). Project participants can be invited to camps and educational activities offered by the Organizer. They have the right to refuse to participate at the time of application.

## **Section 10. Major Force**

For the purpose of this Regulation, Major Force means any event that cannot be controlled, remedied or foreseen by the Organizer, and whose occurrence makes the latter unable to fulfill its obligations under the Regulation. These events include, but are not limited to: wars, fires, floods, strikes and blockades, earthquakes, other disasters of any kind,

as well as any regulations that may arise after the entry into force of the Contract, and that may prohibit or modify the terms of the Information Act, etc.

If a situation of major force , including the impossibility of the Organizer, for reasons beyond his control, prevents or delays in whole or in part, the execution of the Regulation and the continuation of the Project, the Organizer will be exonerated from the liability to fulfill its obligations for the period , according to art.1082 and 1083 of the Civil Code. If the Organizer invokes major force, it is obliged to communicate to the project participants, within 5 days from the occurrence of the case of force majeure, its existence.

### **Section 11. Disputes**

In case of disputes between the Organizer and the participants in the Project, they will be settled amicably.

If it is not possible to resolve the disputes amicably, the parties involved in the dispute will submit the dispute to the competent Romanian courts at the Organizer's headquarters.
